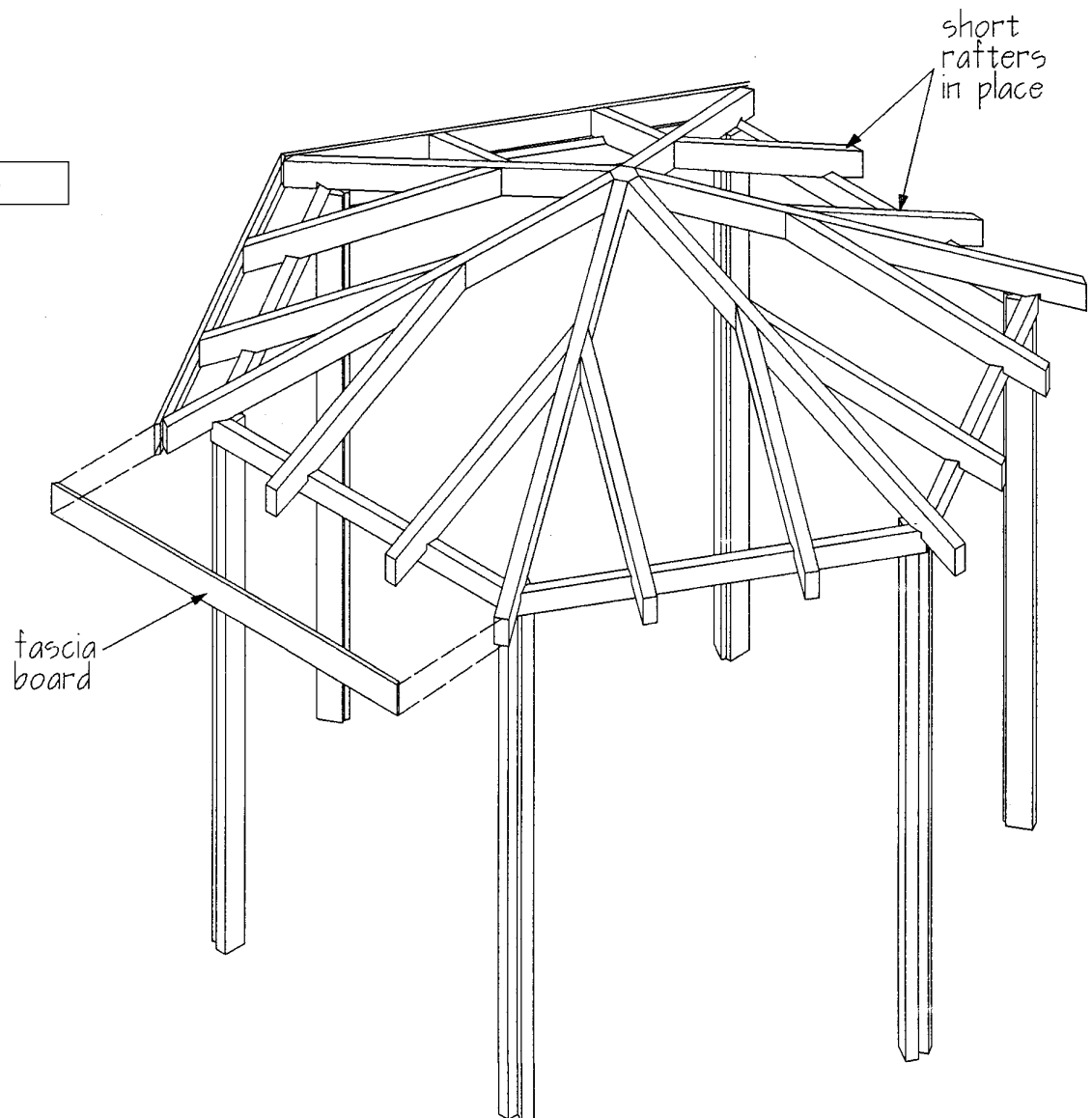


EXPERT ADVICE:

Attach the fascia before securing roof joists to the header to ensure that the roof lines up.

3. Install the short roof rafters using a similar procedure as for the long roof rafters. Using two 3" screws, toenail the short roof rafter to the adjoining long roof rafters. Using two 3" screws, fasten the short roof rafter to the header, as shown in **Figure D4**. Continue until all short roof rafters are fastened in place.
4. Attach fascia now.
5. The 1x4 fascia boards run horizontally from one long rafter to the next. [See **Figure D5**].
6. Have your helper hold one end of the fascia board. Then, using two 2" finishing nails, attach the other end of the fascia board to a long roof rafter. Be sure that the end of the fascia board is flush with the "V" of the long roof rafter. If necessary, adjust the position of the long roof rafter so that the end of the fascia board is flush with the "V" of the long roof rafter. Moving around the Gazebo, complete all fascia boards in the same manner.

C. WALL SECTION ASSEMBLY

Wall assembly can be divided into three stages. First, the sidewall sections are built. Secondly, the posts are attached to these sections. Finally, the completed section is erected and mounted on the deck assembly.
